1. GENERAL

1.1 Organizer

The 9th FAI World Advanced Aerobatic Championships 2010 are organized by the Aero Club of Poland.

1.2 Location, Date and Timetable

1.2.1 The 9th FAI World Advanced Aerobatic Championships 2010 will be held at Radom Sadkow Airport (military airport) between August 5th – 15th, 2010.

Radom – Piastow (very close to Radom – Sadkow) will be the airfield for training.

Availability of Sadkow Airport by the 5th August will be confirmed in Bulletin No 2.

1.2.3 Competition flights will be performed between 09:00 up to sunset

1.2.4 All times are in local time (UTC + 2 hours)

1.2.5 The daily timetable is subject to change due to weather conditions

2. REGULATIONS

2.1 Rules

The 9th FAI World Advanced Aerobatic Championships 2010 will be organized in accordance with the following rules:

- FAI Sporting Code – General Section
- FAI Sporting Code – Section 6, Part I
- Flight Rules published by the Polish Aviation Authority
- Local Regulations

3. OFFICIAL LANGUAGE

3.1 Official Language

The official languages of the 9th FAI World Advanced Aerobatic Championships 2010 are Polish and English. The language of all communications and briefings is English.

4. PARTICIPATION, COMPETITORS AND AIRCRAFTS

4.1 Participants

4.1.1 All NACs, the FAI members, may be represented in the 9th World Advanced Aerobatic Championships 2010 by a team and/or individual competitors/observers.

4.1.2 The competitors have to be members of their National Aero Clubs.

4.1.3 The Entries are to be accepted by National Aero Clubs only.

4.1.4 All competitors have to be holders of:

- a valid Pilot License,
- a valid FAI Sporting License,
- a valid personal insurance policy.

4.2 Aircrafts

4.2.1 All participating aircrafts have to satisfy performance criteria essential for competition flights

4.2.2 A valid aerobatic Certificate of Airworthiness or equivalent document issued by the competent aviation authority of the participant's country must be produced to the organisers for every contest aircraft. (FAI Sporting Code 1.2.6.1)

4.2.3 All participating aircrafts must have the Certificate of Insurance against Third Party Liability covering a minimum limit according to EU 785/2004 Directive 8211, valid for The Republic of Poland for the period of staying there.

4.2.4 Hangar space for competing aircrafts will be available free of charge for the period of the Championships.

4.2.5 Fuel will be supplied by the organizer.

- AVGAS: 100 LL
- Oil: Shell W 100

5. TEAM COMPOSITIONS

5.1 Competitors

The entries for competitors are accepted by the National Aero Clubs according to FAI Sporting Code, Section 6, 1.2.4.1.b.

5.2 Officials

The officials, as defined in FAI Sporting Code, Section 6, may enter as the National Team members.

5.3 Observers

The relatives of competitors are accepted as observers of national team. The entry fee for observers is the same as for regular team members.

6. ENTRY FEE

6.1. Entry fees

- o Competitors..... EUR 1 650
- o Other team members and observers..... EUR 1 400

The entry fees cover:

- o Fuel and oil for competition flights
- o Shared accommodation – double room
- o Breakfast, lunch and dinner
- o Transport between airfields and places of accommodation
- o Official and social functions
- o Programmes arranged by the organizer

Note: A single room supplement applies – EUR 15 per night

6.2 Deadline for entries

Deadline for Preliminary Entries: the 1st of April 2010. The Official Entry Forms along with Entry Fees and Participants Questionnaires are to be received by the organizer no later than 15th of May.

Any delays up to June 15th are charged additional EUR 100, any delays up to July 15th – EUR 150. If payment is made at the contest site, an additional EUR 200 will be charged.

Protest can be submitted by paying EUR 100.
