2 SCHEDULE

- 2.1 The contest dates are finalised, but the detailed schedule is provisional and subject to change.
The 9th FAI World Advanced Aerobatic Championships 2010 will be held at Radom Sadkow Airport (military airport) between August 5th – 15th , 2010.

2.3 Competition flights will be performed between 09:00 up to sunset

2.4 All times are in local time (UTC + 2 hours)

2.5 The daily timetable is subject to change due to weather conditions

3 TRAINING SITES

3.1 The organizer has identified a small number of airfields in Poland that are prepared to host training camps ahead of AWAC 2010. It is unlikely that all team will have exclusive use of any single site and it will be difficult to offer training sites in Poland to all participants.

3.2 Priority will be given to teams who asks for assistance first then to other teams travelling a long distance to the contest.

3.3 Piastow-Radom airfield will be available for trainings for all participants starting from July 27th, prior to earlier bookings.

3.4 Sadkow-Radom airfield will be available for trainings for all participants starting from August 2nd.

3.5 Detailed information on both airfields will be issued in Bulletin 3.

4 FUEL

4.1 Fuel for competitor flights will be supplied by the organizer.

4.2 Fuel for training flights and departures:

o AVGAS: 100 LL – Euro 2 per liter

o Oil: Shell W 100 – Euro 8 per liter

5 FACILITIES

5.1 Hangarage: for all aircrafts free of charge

5.2 Hotel Accommodation: Detailed information about the hotels will be issued in Bulletin 3. The contest entry fees include accommodation from the 5th to 15th August, with departures on the 15th August. While staying at the contest hotel all participants will be responsible for paying the cost of any additional food, drink or services they order at the hotel.

5.3 Food: Breakfast and dinner (two courses) at the hotels are included. Lunch will be served for all participants at Sadkow airfield.

5.4 Attendance at the Opening and Closing Ceremonies is included.

6 ENTRY PROCESS

- 6.1 All participants of the AWAC (pilots, team members, observers) have to be registered prior to the Championships. Due to the fact that the Championships will be held at the military airfield all participants have to be provided with special ID. Participants without ID will not be allowed to enter the participants' area at the airfield.

- 6.3 All NACs must send one Team Entry Form and an Individual Entry Form for each team member (pilots and non-pilots, including observers) no later than May 31.

7 REFUND POLICY

- 7.1 Refund Policy: If an entered pilot or official has to withdraw, his/her NAC may substitute another pilot or official with no financial penalty. If a participant wishes to cancel their entry for AWAC 2010, the NAC must contact the Contest Registrar in writing to withdraw the participant. The date of withdrawal will be noted by the Registrar and will set the proportion of the fee to be refunded by the Organising Body thus:

Date Cancellation received by Contest Registrar	Proportion of Fee to be Refunded
On or before June 30th	100%
July 1st – July 15th	50%
July 16th – July 31th	30%
August 1st onwards	0%

- 7.2 If a competitor is disqualified from the event by the International Jury or Chief Judge, none of the entry fee will be refunded.

8 FREE PROGRAMME SUBMISSION

- 8.1 Free programmes must be submitted electronically in either Aresti Visio or Olan format. Free Programmes can be emailed to the contest Registrar at info@awac2010.pl. Competitors who intend to submit their Free Programme at Registration should bring it on a memory stick.
